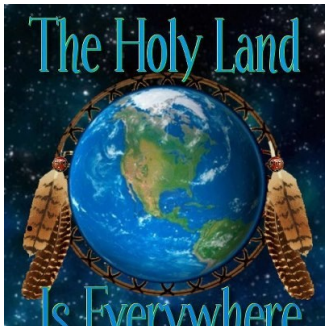


From Susan Stanton: About the vision

Grandmothers Circle the Earth is one of many Indigenous Grandmothers Organizations currently forming around the World in fulfillment of Prophecy! We were called into being in 2009 in response to the Vision of our Elder Leon Secatero, a Navajo Grandfather and one of the Spiritual Elders of Mother Earth. These Elders - Men and Women from Siberia, Turtle Island, South America and more - had been traveling for many years in two's burying crystals where the Ley Lines intersect on Mother Earth. These crystals were activated to strengthen the Energetic Net and stabilize the world during this time of Earth Changes.

Grandfather Leon and the Elders sent us outward to call Councils and Circles into being with the goal to strengthen Grandmothers in their communities to create programs and protect the future for the Seventh Generation. At first we thought this would be on Turtle Island, then Hawaii opened to us, then New Zealand, then Europe, now Africa, Cuba, Ecuador, Peru and Chile have called for us. We asked some Grandfathers to help us and we now work together on behalf of Men and Children and the Environment. Indeed, All Life on Mother Earth is our "Kuleana" our responsibility, and we are working hard.

The 13 Indigenous Grandmothers with the Center for Sacred Studies have opened the way for all of the Circles, for as Mona Polacca shared with me "this is the Vision". They go into communities worldwide and awake the People to the Role of the Grandmother. Once the community has awakened Grandmothers Circle the Earth comes in and helps Councils and Circles to organize!



This February I was part of the filming of a Documentary at the United Nations Commission on the Status of Women. The 13 International Grandmothers event coordinator Audrey and I were interviewed together to discuss our Projects. It became instantly clear as we talked together that we are engaged in the same work ~ fulfillment of Prophecy in these Times to secure the future for the Seventh Generation. Our message is that we are all Indigenous to Mother Earth! We are working together to Heal the Future!
